GABARITO

- “Any society in which the guarantee of rights is not assured, nor the separation of powers determined, has no Constitution” is an **article** included in the **Declaration** of the **Rights** of **Man** and of the **Citizen** of **1789** (6 items)
- Considering a norm to be **constitutional** presupposes the a priori **category** of the **constitution** (3 items)
- Unlike other sorts of regulations, the author categorizes constitutions as special cases due to the fact those are **single**, **basic**, **rigid**, **vague**, and **enduring** laws (5 items)
- A **non** **posited** **basic** norm is the perception of **Kelsen** towards an act of will as a constitutional law - the highest in the hierarchy of **positive** laws. (5 items)
- The author vindicates a unique conception of constitutional law and interpretation, and downplaying the significance of contingencies of form, language, structure, and history in constitutional **argument**. (1 item)
